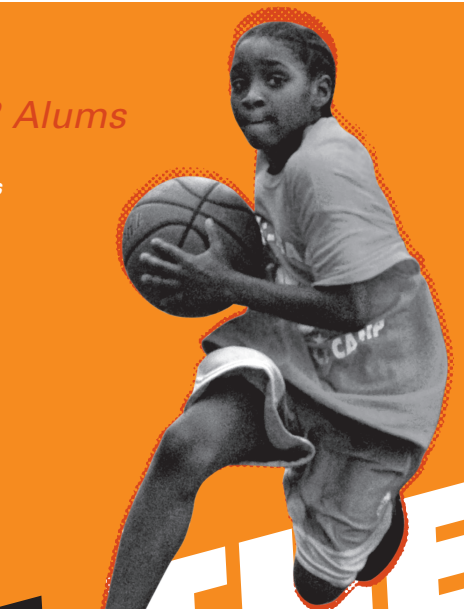

MIKE HIBBS has been coaching in the Washington metropolitan area for the past 29 years at every level through varsity high school. He is in his fourth year at Good Counsel High School, where he is in the midst of rebuilding the program. He more than doubled the team's win total from his first year to his second, becoming much more competitive in the process. In recognition of this fact, Coach Hibbs received Coach of the Year honors. Prior to coaching at Good Counsel, he coached one season at Loyola High School in Baltimore and 12 years at The Bullis School in Potomac. While at Bullis, he turned the program into a perennial favorite, winning six league titles. He was named Coach of the Year during each of those championship years and twice named Montgomery County Coach of the Year. Hibbs was also selected to coach the Capital All-Stars in the prestigious Capital Classic in 1997. He has lectured at many of the best camps and coaching clinics on the East Coast, including the prestigious D.C. Basketball Coaches' Clinic.

MIKE JONES is now in his seventh season as varsity basketball coach at DeMatha Catholic High School. In six years, Jones has compiled a 145-47 record. In 2006-2007, DeMatha won the school's third straight conference title, and earned the #1 ranking by The Washington Post for the second straight year. The 2005-06 Stags were ranked #1 in the country by Hoops USA and #4 nationally by USA Today. Coach Jones was named 'Coach-of-the-Year' in 2005 by The Washington Post and was coach of the local team in the 2007 Capital Classic. Coach Jones was a member of the 1991 DeMatha varsity basketball team, which went undefeated. He went on to play at Old Dominion where he helped lead the Monarchs to two NCAA tournament appearances. Upon graduation, he played professionally in the United States, Europe, and Asia.

STEVE TURNER is entering his fifth season as the head basketball coach at Gonzaga College High School. In the 2007-08 season, he led the Eagles to a 34-1 record, winning the WCAC, the D.C. City title and the Alhambra Catholic Invitational Tournament. Coach Turner was named the 2008 WCAC Coach of the Year. He previously served as an assistant to legendary Hall of Fame Coach Dick Myers for five years. Since Coach Turner arrived at Gonzaga, he has helped develop players who have gone on to play at colleges such as West Virginia, LaSalle, Cornell, Princeton, St. Francis, Marshall, Niagara and Harvard. Coach Turner is regarded as one of the top-rising high school basketball coaches in the D.C. area. He is respected as a game strategist and as a coach who gets the best out of each player.
